THE RADIO HOUR

With influences that combine southern gothic, surreal 70's prog, and folk-punk genres, Chicago-based The Radio Hour presents a catalog of stark, melodic material with dramatic swings in mood and presentation. Lollipop Magazine writes "The Radio Hour has a conviction all its own, still discovering the nature of pain and experience, measuring, years before judging."

The Radio Hour is the moniker for the songwriting and production efforts of Tim Hort. It is Hort's exposed search for redemption that creates a tone in the vein of Peter Gabriel, Johnny Cash, Chan Marshall or Leonard Cohen. Hort's recordings have drawn comparisons like "early REM in an Xbox," or "Paul Simon meets Pink Floyd."

College Music Journal has endorsed The Radio Hour as its "A&R PICK." The first full-length release, World's Worst Antenna, was a true-to-analog studio pop project. The second full-length CD, entitled The Radio Hour (identifiable by the cover photo of an angel flying up catch a suicide jumper) has a dark and surreal flavor. It is an idiosyncratic collection of world-weary songs that have a lasting sense of melody and an appealing sense for introspection. Blaise Barton, whose credits also include Bob Dylan and Liz Phair, engineered the CD.

The latest release from The Radio Hour is a five-song studio effort (with an additional acoustic demo track), simply called *The Radio Hour EP* (featuring cover artwork of an angel with half-mast flags seen in the background). The EP, with its highly melodic content, contains a pensive, sign-of-the-times overcast tone and a confessional delivery. The CD was written and produced by Hort, and it was mixed and mastered by Barton. (See "Lyrics.pdf" on the enhanced CD for more information and full credits.)
